Consensus Building Process on Library Services Moves Forward

CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PA – In conjunction with the Cumberland County Commissioners, the Cumberland County Library System Board has engaged Monica Gould, MBA, CMC of Strategic Consulting Partners to develop and facilitate a consensus-building process regarding the future of library services in Cumberland County.

The purpose of this process is for the County Commissioners and the Library System Board to reach consensus on the Library System’s vision, roles and services, as well as a business model that includes long-term, sustainable funding strategies for the next three to five years.

Gould’s work began upon contract signing on Monday, November 17, 2014 and is expected to conclude by spring 2015.
