Cumberland County Libraries Closed for Staff Training on October 30

(Carlisle, PA) – All public libraries in Cumberland County will be closed on Wednesday, October 30, 2013 so that library staff may attend continuing education at Bosler Memorial Library about how to keep the county’s libraries safe and friendly spaces for information and learning.

“This annual event keeps staff trained and up-to-date on services that affect Cumberland County libraries,” said training services coordinator Carolyn Blatchley. “While the libraries are closed, online services such as the library catalog, research databases, eBooks and our automated telephone circulation system will continue to be available.”

No items are due on October 30, and normal operating hours at all locations will resume on Thursday, October 31. For those who do visit while libraries are closed, all locations have a either an outdoor return bin or a book depository slot to return items.
