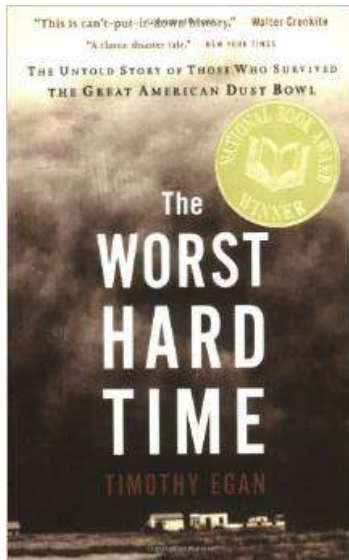
Happy Birthday John Graham!

John Graham was born on August 4th, 1843 in West Pennsboro Township. Following graduation from business school in New York, he became a store owner for two years. He worked as a bookkeeper at First National Bank for six years, was co-owner of a tannery, served two terms as a State Representative, and was involved in the trolley business in Wilkes Barre and Cumberland County. He owned ten farms in the Newville area. When John Graham died in 1915, his will directed that his house was to be used for a library.

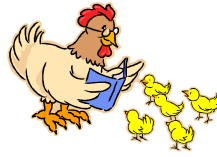
Regular Library Hours Resume September 1st
