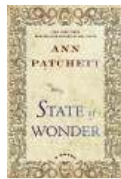

Book Club

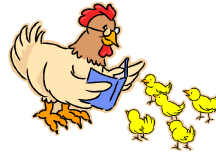
The John Graham Library's Book Club meets at 1:00 pm on the first Monday of every month from October through May.
