Farmers' Market

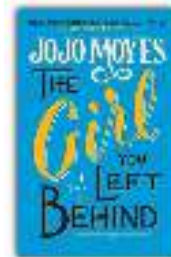
The Farmers' Market has reached the end of its season and will reopen next May. Thank you to all of our great vendors and customers!

Book Club

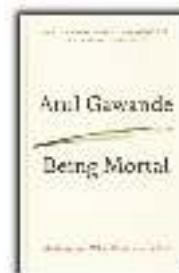

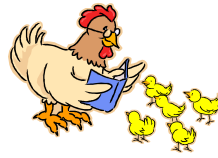

Upcoming Storytimes will feature the following themes:

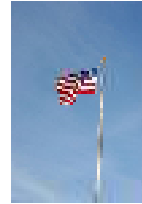
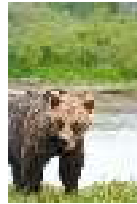
November 3rd: Mice (Special visitor coming!)
