Have a Cumberland County Library Card? Get Free Online Tutoring

Mechanicsburg, PA – The Cumberland County Library System today launched the new database Tutor.com, which is available to county residents and cardholders. This new service will provide in-depth homework and career assistance to students and adults.

Tutor.com allows library cardholders access to live online tutoring and resume help as well as thousands of academic and career resources. Students from K-12 through college can get help with homework, studying, projects, essay writing, and test prep in every subject, including algebra, statistics, chemistry, physics, social studies, and English. Adults can get help with job searches, GED prep, and academic support.

All sessions are online with a professional academic or career tutor. Tutor.com, available seven days a week between 12 p.m. and 12 a.m., can be accessed from any computer or mobile device (smartphone or tablet with internet access). Patrons will need their library account barcode or username and PIN to log in.

“As part of our ongoing commitment to bringing the best services and programs to the county, Tutor.com is just the latest of dozens of free databases and other resources available to anyone with a library card,” said Carolyn Blatchley, executive director of the Cumberland County Library System.
