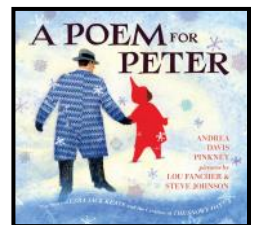

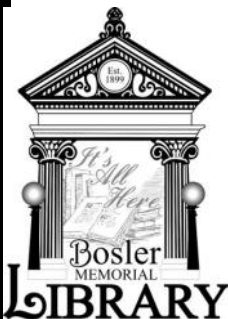

Amy Bates

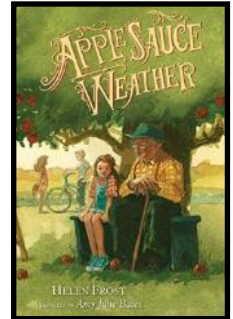

Matt Novak

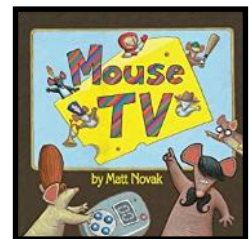

A Whale of An Adventure! Escape Room

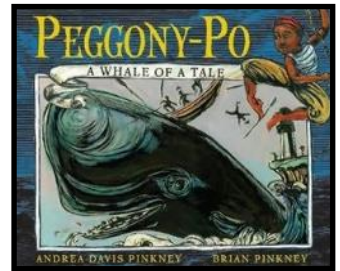

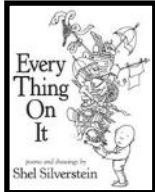
