Session 3: Wednesday, May 15 from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm

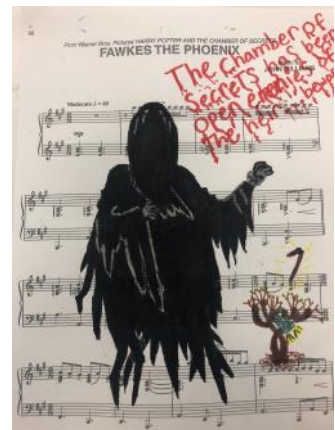
