Fingerprinting and Passport Services come to Bosler

You may have noticed a crowd forming at the end of the Public Services Desk on the first floor during one of your recent visits to the Library. In November, Bosler Memorial Library became an official fingerprinting center for IDEMIA, the PA State contractor for fingerprinting services through their IdentoGo identity services.

Fingerprinting is a growing need across the nation as more employers, licensing agencies and volunteer organizations are required to adhere to more stringent checks to ensure the safety of their organizations and the people that they serve. Library staff, using IdentoGo equipment, capture an applicant's fingerprints and submit them to IdentoGo. They in turn submit them to the Pennsylvania State Police who process them through the state's Automated Fingerprint Identifying System (AFIS) and then pass them on to the FBI. The results are returned to the originating agency, employer or organization.






The following courses are coming up in February. Don't forget to register by calling the Information Services Desk at (717) 243-4642.
