Carlisle's own Ajay Shughart has been playing guitar since age 9. He was singing and leading bands by age 12 and released his first CD at age 14. As he matured, so did his music. He soon added electric bass and music production to his repertoire.

Currently living in Philadelphia, he'll be returning home to share his latest music with new and old friends. His current musical stylings can be described as a fusion of harmonic R&B, hip-hop and synth-infused rhythms with influences from a range of modern jazz and indie/alternative sounds. His live performances are energetic and spontaneous recreations of his self-produced songs. These genre-busting sounds will appeal to both modern and retro listeners.

Get Ready for our Fall Programs!


Our fall program booklets for the Carlisle Institute for Lifelong Learning and our Growing Learners Library are now available!
