They Meet Again on the Gettysburg Battlefield - The 1913 Veterans Reunion

The Battle of Gettysburg turned the tide of the American Civil War. 50 years later, from June 29-July 4, 1913, to commemorate the anniversary of The Battle of Gettysburg, more than 50,000 Civil War veterans and thousands of spectators descended on the rolling hills and the town of Gettysburg. This time, they returned as comrades in arms, enemies no longer, and they were participants in the largest Civil War Reunion ever held, known as the Grand Reunion.

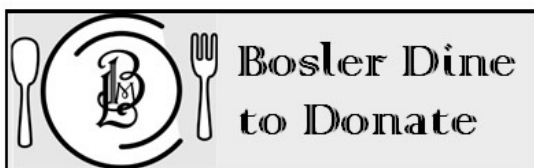
Join historical reenactor and lecturer, Michael Jesberger, for a discussion on this often overlooked story of the American Civil War.

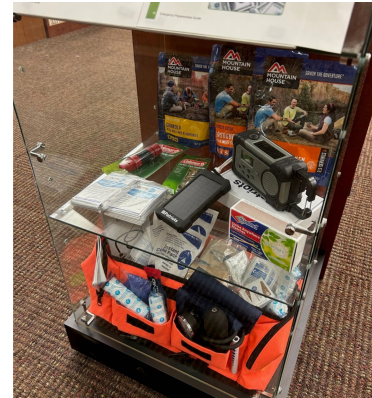
