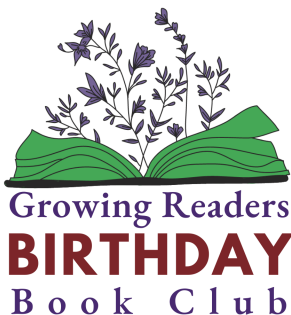


Adult LEGO Club

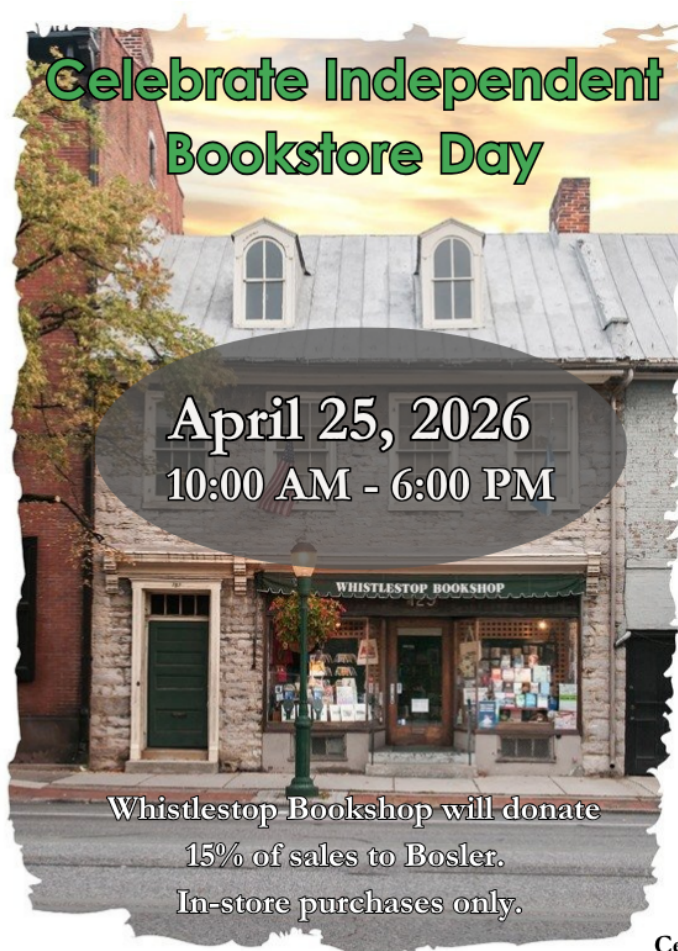
