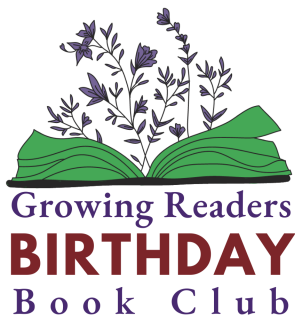


Adult LEGO Club

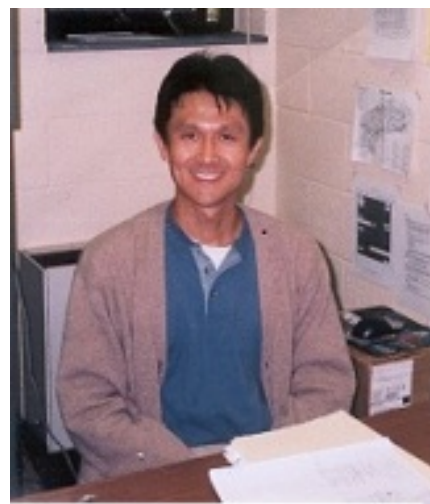
With the funds received from Match Madness, Bosler will be able to expand our collections and program offerings, and increase our level of service to library visitors of all ages.
