**The Growing Learner's Library Program Booklet** is published in the spring and fall of each year. It contains information about the exciting activities for you and your family at the Library. Please keep the following in mind as you plan your library visits:

- **Youth Services programs are designed for attendance by both children and their adult parent/caregiver. Please be prepared to stay and enjoy the program with your child. Our attended child policy requires a parent, guardian, or caregiver to accompany children under the age of 12 at all times.**
- We understand that learning is not linear. Our program room is a safe learning space where children are respected for who they are and where they are at in their learning journey. We welcome you no matter what your journey looks like and expect all families in our programs to do the same.
- When registering for programs that run for multiple weeks (indicated in the booklet), you are registering to attend each week of the program.
- If you register for a program and discover that you cannot attend, please contact the Youth Services Department at (717) 243-4642, ext. 2231 to be removed from our registration list so that others on the waiting list can attend. For multiple class programs, your children will get the most out of the program if they attend all of the classes. If you find you are unable to attend at least three or more of the classes, please consider registering at another time.
- We understand that sometimes a child needs a break. Please feel free to step out of a program if necessary and rejoin us later.

# Program Spotlight: Play and Learn Groups

In this partnership with United Way's Success by Six Initiative preschoolers and their caregivers are invited to join our school readiness Play and Learn Groups. Play and Learn groups bring children and caregivers together to participate in a variety of preschool activities. Each session focuses on a theme for the day. Children will participate in songs, movement, read-alouds, and hands-on activities centered on that theme. Children will receive a new book and extension activity to take home at the end of each session. This is also a time for caregivers to learn something new! For ages 3 to 6 years. Registration for each group is required. We have three groups in the spring, learn more about them further in this booklet!



## Storytimes

**Benefits of Storytimes:** Reading to children helps to promote healthy brain development as well as grow their vocabulary and listening skills. Listening to stories can also improve their focus and concentration. Exploring different stories is a great way for children to explore the world around them in a safe and comfortable manner while also encouraging the use of their imagination. It allows them to discover new things and learn to ask questions about what they are seeing or hearing. This can also help build their social emotional skills by using stories to help process emotions or situations that they may be facing.

All of this starts as early as infancy, which is why we offer three different storytimes for different developmental stages. There is Baby Time for birth to 18 months, Toddler Tales for 19 to 35 months, and Preschool Storytime for 3 to 6 year olds. All of our storytimes use a mix of books, songs, rhymes, finger plays, and hands-on activities to help your child explore their world and discover new things. You can learn more about our storytimes and when they are offered further in this booklet.

Our regular storytimes have changed format, they will now be available all year long, every week! Check below to see the ages and days and times available.

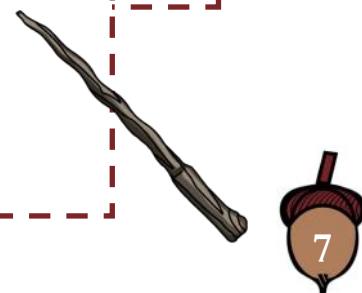

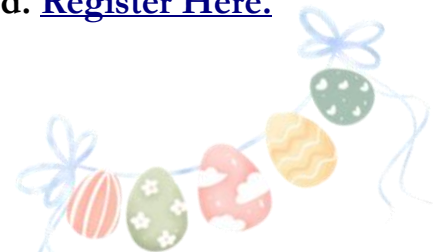
