While at the System Headquarters, Linda also learned the Processing Clerk's job, so she can step in during his absence to keep materials flowing out the door. She's happy to shift gears at a moment's notice to work on whatever job is most pressing at the moment.

Linda's library career started right after college, when she began working as a clerk in the children's department of a library in Huntingdon, West Virginia. She became director of Bosler Library, where she served until her retirement — her first retirement.
