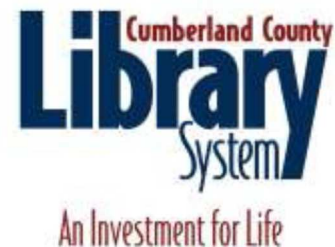

Cumberland County Libraries Closed for Staff Training on November 18

(Carlisle, PA) – All public libraries in Cumberland County will be closed on Wednesday, November 18 so that library staff may attend a continuing education event in Carlisle.

“This annual event keeps staff trained and up-to-date on skills that affect the way we serve our communities,” said public services and staff training coordinator Carolyn Blatchley. “While our libraries are closed, online services such as the library catalog, research databases, eBooks and our automated telephone circulation system will continue to be available.”

Items will not be due on November 18. Normal operating hours at all locations will resume on Thursday, November 19. For those who do visit while libraries are closed, all locations have either outdoor return bins or depository slots to return items.
