What's New at East Pennsboro Branch Library?


Since 1985, East Pennsboro Branch Library has occupied three rooms on the second floor of the Township Municipal Building, once the Midway School. Initially, the Branch's collection was created from West Shore Public Library's reserve collection of duplicate books. Also, as an Eagle Scout project, Jim Tezik spearheaded a drive that garnered 1,127 books to be added to the collection or sold to provide money for newer books. Today, the collection has grown to almost 17,000 items!

This space has served the community well for the past 31 years. After Thanksgiving, the library will close and relocate to our newly renovated space on the ground floor of the building. Not only will this new location feature a more user-friendly layout, additional seating, and an outside entrance, but we will also share the ground floor with the Friends book store as well as the Senior Center. Special thanks to the Township Commissioners for their outstanding support of the library and to the Township staff for their excellent workmanship in renovating the former gymnasium and transforming it into our wonderful new library.

We will reopen on Monday, December 5 in our new space. We have many holiday events planned - check our calendar of events for details. And in January, for the first time ever, we will be open on Saturdays from 10am to 2pm.

Be sure to join the Friends of East Pennsboro Library on January 4 at 6 pm for a grand opening celebration.
