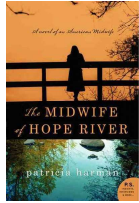

Lego Club

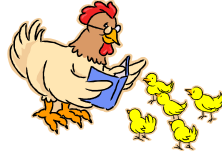
Our Lego Club meets on the second Saturday of the month at 1:00 pm. All children are welcome. We provide the Legos, just bring your imagination!
