

## **The John Graham Library's building is open to the public with limitations.**

- Please maintain 6 feet of physical distancing between you and another person. Please follow all signs and floor markers.
- Persons entering the building are **required to wear a mask**, as ordered by the Secretary of Health.
  - If you do not have a mask, we will provide you with a disposable one free of charge.
- Hand sanitizer stations can be found throughout the building.
- We offer a *contact-free holds pickup service* for those who prefer it. Place holds on items by calling the library at 717-776-5900 or visiting <https://catalog.cumberlandcountylibraries.org>. We'll let you know when your holds are available. Contact the library to arrange a pickup time, and we'll take your items to a table on the front porch.
- All items must be returned in the Book Drop on the front porch. Returned items will be quarantined for 3 days before being checked in. This delay will not cause any fines.

- Computer availability is limited. Sessions will be limited to 30 minutes if another person is waiting for the computer. We also have laptop computers that can be checked out for in-library use, or you can bring your own device and use our free Wi-Fi.
