



NEW TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS

On December 10, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania announced new restrictions to try to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and avoid overwhelming our hospitals and healthcare facilities.

The library will remain open at this point to provide essential service to our community.

We will do our part to protect our patrons and staff by implementing new policies & procedures to minimize indoor gathering and face-to-face interactions with the following temporary restrictions.

Limit your library use to brief browsing and checking out materials.

There will be no seating available.

Limit computer use to a minimum and only if necessary. There will be no staff assistance available.

All patrons who enter the building are required to wear a cloth face mask or surgical mask that fully covers the mouth and nose. Those that cannot wear a face mask, including children, should use our curbside pickup service instead. No exceptions at this time.

Use Curbside pickup for your holds, whenever possible or needed. Call the library at 717-774-7820 before your arrival. Please allow 5 to 10 minutes for staff to retrieve and check out your items. They will be delivered outside the door, checked out to you.

Please do not use the Library if you have a cough, feel ill or have been advised to quarantine.
