

VOLUNTEER WORK DAY
NEW CUMBERLAND LIBRARY

Below are some of the projects that need attention on the library grounds ALL of these tasks would require gardening gloves!

WEEDING – pulling and digging is required – shovels and handheld trowels are needed for this

PRUNING – there are many shrubs on the grounds that would benefit from being cut back and thinned out – handheld clippers, especially those that “ratchet” and larger “lopper” type tools would be useful

REMOVAL OR CUTTING BACK – this task would apply to annual flowers that will die over the winter or perennials that benefit from being cut back – removal could involve pulling or digging, handheld clippers are used for cutting back

SOIL TURNOVER – some areas will benefit from having the soil dug up and turned over and smoothed out – shovels and rakes are needed for this effort

EDGING – many of the areas need an edge dug to define the beds – shovels work well for this effort

SWEEPING – there are multiple sidewalks plus the memorial brick edging that can be swept and cleaned – brooms would be needed for this as well as dust pans to pick up debris

PENN-CUMBERLAND GARDEN CLUB maintains 6 separate spaces on the grounds of the library. We do have help from the Highway Department of the Borough but there are always tasks that we are behind on every season. Your help will be very much appreciated – garden club members will work with you!
