

Homeschool Spanish Club

We are starting a High School Spanish Club for homeschool students who have completed at least a high school level Spanish 1. Cost will be \$5 per person/per meeting which can be paid the day of the club. We will meet bi-weekly on Thursdays at the Shippensburg Public Library from 1 - 2:30 p.m. upstairs in the reference room. The club will be facilitated by fluent bilingual individuals. The purpose of this club is to give teens opportunities to practice their Spanish in a conversational, non-threatening environment. This would be in addition to their regular Spanish course (the instructors will be assuming that the students will be continuing to learn Spanish on their own and will have enough to practice conversation with). This will not be in place of a curriculum.
