

Earth Day Minute-to-Win-It Game Cards

Materials: Recycling materials and three boxes. Label one box for paper, one box for plastic, and one box for cans.

Directions: Race to see who can sort the most recyclable materials in a minute.

Materials: Empty soda (pop) cans—if you don't have soda cans you can use empty plastic cups.

Directions: See who can stack the most empty soda cans without it toppling over in a minute. If you are using plastic cups you will need to stack each one the opposite way.

Materials: Paper flyers or junk mail folded into a paper airplane and masking tape.

Directions: Use the tape to make a starting line. See who can fly the plane the farthest. One adult needs to measure and place a piece of tape where the airplane landed. And the contestant can run and grab their plane and try to fly it again or make another if they think it will go farther.

Materials: Paper flyers or junk mail folded into 15 or more paper airplane, recycling box, and masking tape.

Directions: Use the tape to make a starting line. See how many paper airplanes you can get in the recycling box in one minute. If you run out of airplanes the player can run around and collect them.

Materials: egg carton with marked points in each slot with a magic marker, water bottle caps and masking tape.

Directions: Use the tape to make a starting line. See how many points you can get in a minute by tossing water bottle caps.



Materials: One empty water bottle, and one postcard junk mail approximately 4" by 4" in size.

Directions: Pull the paper from under the water bottle without knocking the bottle over and see who can do this the most times within a minute.
